AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION

- 1. Purpose of Report.
- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to seek Council's approval of proposed amendments to the Constitution.
- 2. Connection to Corporate Improvement Plan / Other Corporate Priority.
- 2.1 The Constitution governs the operation of the Authority and thereby connects to the Corporate Improvement Plan and all Corporate Priorities:
 - 1. **Supporting a successful economy** taking steps to make the County a good place to do business, for people to live, work, study and visit, and to ensure that our schools are focused on raising the skills, qualifications and ambitions of all people in the county.
 - 2. **Helping people to be more self-reliant** taking early steps to reduce or prevent people from becoming vulnerable or dependent on the Council and its services.
 - 3. **Smarter use of resources** ensuring that all its resources (financial, physical, human and technological) are used as effectively and efficiently as possible and support the development of resources throughout the community that can help deliver the Council's priorities.
- 3. Background.
- 3.1 A desktop review of the Constitution has been undertaken to ensure that it is up to date and fit for purpose.
- 4. Current situation / proposal.
- 4.1 The recent changes to the structure and personnel within the Operational and Partnership Services Directorate require changes to the Constitution. It is recommended that all references within the Constitution to the Corporate Director Operational and Partnership Services are deleted and replaced with Solicitor to the Council.
