Role & Responsibilities

I was elected to Bridgend County Borough Council to represent (Ogmore Vale) on (13.11.15). I have undertaken a variety of roles within the Council this year including being appointed to several committees.

I have supported the residents of my ward on a variety of issues and have formally raised (**) constituent queries with the Council and other organisations. This is in addition to informally addressing a number of other issues which you have asked me to help you resolve.

To enable me to fulfil my role as your representative, I have attended a number of Member Development Activities which have assisted me to ensure that my knowledge of national and local issues affecting the Council and my ward is maintained.

This year I have continued to attend, promote and support as many activities taking place in my community as possible, these include Ogmore Valley Male Voice Choir Concerts, fundays on the Planka and launching the Cwrt Gwalia Sunflower Garden. Like last year I continued to work on key issues such as street lighting, street cleansing, waste and recycling, fly-tipping, pot-holes, anti-social behaviour at the Chapel on Bethania Row. I am actively involved with the Ogmore Valley Community Council, where I have helped drive the forward the Community Forum, the purchase of additional Christmas Lights, investment in the summer playscheme, and working strategically – Ogmore valley washeries. I meet regularly with the local community co-orindator and the PCSOs to cross refer issues.

I have held a number of meetings and have been successful in obtaining grant funding for a consultant to work with us on the all-weather pitch. I am working with a small group of volunteers to fund replacement play equipment at Wyndham Park.
