510 BT OPENREACH COMMUNICATION BOXES

The Corporate Director - Communities submitted a report together with Appendix 'B', regarding a previous issue highlighted in respect of the erection of communication boxes in Bridgend.

The Transportation Control Manager had notified Members on the location of the proposed communication boxes, and the Development Control Committee previously agreed that the Council contacts WAG requesting that it reassesses the permitted development arrangements for statutory undertakers, and to introduce a requirement to notify local residents of the undertaker's proposed development.

The Planning Division of the Welsh Assembly Government had responded to the above action, and stated that it had no plans for any specific review of the permitted development rights enjoyed by the utilities, and a copy of the letter was attached at Appendix 'B' to the report.

The Transportation Control Manager advised, that the list of such sites that went to the Committee previously would be sent to Members at the earliest convenience, as would the sites in Pencoed when they were received.

RESOLVED: That the report be noted.

511 PLANNING APPLICATION P/08/1131/OUT

The Group Manager Development submitted a report together with Appendix 'C', which reminded Committee of a previous decision made to grant conditional consent for the above planning application.

He explained however, that this decision was made subject to the completion of a Section 106 Agreement which had subsequently not been progressed.

The recommendation therefore to refuse the application was now being made, as the application was currently un-determined which was impacting upon the Planning Department's performance indicators which could affect the securing of future grant funding.

<u>RESOLVED</u>: That planning permission for the above application, be

refused for the following reasons:-

- (1) The development makes no provision for the provision of affordable housing which is contrary to Policy H7 of the Bridgend Unitary Development Plan, and the Council's Supplementary Planning Guidance (SPG) 13 - Affordable Housing.
- (2) The proposed development would not provide a children's playing space or a contribution to enhance open space and children's play facilities in the area, which is required for all new housing development and is therefore contrary to Policy RC5 of the Bridgend Unitary Development Plan.
