FINAL STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS 2005-06

1. Purpose of the Report

2. Background

- 2.1 The draft Statement of Accounts for 2005/06 was presented to Council on the 19th July 2006. During the intervening period, the external audit has taken place resulting in a small number of amendments being made to the financial statements.
- 2.2 The updated Statement of Accounts is attached at Appendix 1 and is due to be signed off as "presenting fairly the financial position of the Council at 31st March 2006".
