

Bakers Way

Information for Children and Young People





Bakers Way is a house with five bedrooms where children and young people come for short stays. A short stay can be a tea visit or a sleep over.

At Bakers Way you will meet new friends

or may even meet people you already know. You can learn new things and develop new skills.

We go on trips to the beach, lots of parks, the cinema and shopping. We also go walking or even just for a drive in our minibus.

There are lots of things to do if we stay in, such as painting, colouring, drawing, watching DVDs and playing.

We have plenty of toys inside the house as well as in the garden where we have a swing and roundabout and other playthings.





If you want some quiet time then we have a soft play/sensory room with relaxing music and plenty of soft cuddly toys.

All our bedrooms are nice and comfortable. You can bring some of your favourite things with you when you stay.

If you have difficulties climbing the stairs then don't worry as we have two downstairs bedrooms.

If you don't sleep very well, there is always someone awake to look after you.

The staff at Bakers Way are very friendly, caring and sensitive. They are here to look after you and give you support.

If you need help to wash, dress or even feed yourself, the staff are on hand to help you.

You may need to take medicines or eat special food. The staff will also help you with this.



If you would like to come and stay at Bakers Way, these are the things we need to do:

- Your social worker will arrange for you and your parents to visit Bakers Way;
- If you are all happy with what you see, your social worker will arrange with the manager of Bakers Way for you to start coming for tea;
- Usually you come for six tea visits. This means you come straight from school or your mum and dad may bring you;
- When you get here you will have tea with the other children who are also staying at Bakers Way.

You can make new friends and play with the toys and games. If you have any worries or questions when you are at Bakers Way, the staff will help you.
