## Analysis of Teachers and Headteachers in Wales as at 18<sup>th</sup> September 2012.

The information included in the following tables has been sourced from the General Teaching Council for Wales' teacher records. The information is correct as at 18<sup>th</sup> September 2012 however, there are a large number of employment changes within the sector at the start of the autumn term.

Unfortunately, GTCW was not able to provide specific figures for faith schools as these cannot be identified from within the sector. The data relates to the first employment held on a teacher's record regardless of whether they are employed by more than one LEA. From the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 the Welsh Government introduced a new sector category of "Middle" school and there are 4 such schools established so far. 4,839 teachers whose records indicate they are undertaking supply work have NOT been included in the tables below as their sector work is unknown. In addition, 410 teachers working in either the Independent sector, FE/HE, England or Overseas have NOT been included in the tables below and 3,536 registered teachers have blank employment records or are not working as qualified teachers and so have NOT been included in the tables below.

The "Other" column under sector in all tables may include teachers with one of the following employment descriptions:

Primary and secondary teaching under Section 56 Of Education Act 1944
Service as a teacher in practical instruction centres
Service in any other primary and secondary centre
Service in remedial centres providing primary and secondary education

Teacher's working in a Pupil Referral Unit
