## REPORT OF THE ASSISTANT CHIEF EXECUTIVE - LEGAL AND REGULATORY SERVICES

#### NOMINATION AND APPOINTMENT TO THE RIGHTS OF WAY SUB-COMMITTEE

- 1. Purpose of Report.
- 1.1 The purpose of this report is for the Development Control Committee to nominate and appoint the members of the Rights of Way Sub-Committee.
- 2. Connection to Corporate Plan / Other Corporate Priority.
- 2.1 The establishment of necessary Committees and other bodies fulfills the requirements of the Constitution and enables the Authority to work towards the successful achievement of all its Corporate Priorities.
- 3. Background.
- 3.1 At a meeting of Council on 21 May 2008, it was agreed that the Rights of Way Panel become a Sub- Committee of the Planning and Development Committee and be re-named the Rights of Way Sub-Committee.
- 3.2 At a meeting of Council on 3 December 2008, adjustments were made to the size and political balance of committees which included the re-designation of the Planning and Development Committee as Development Control Committee. This Committee would comprise of 18 Members, and be established from 1 January 2009.
- 3.3 The remit of the Development Control Committee included the nomination and appointment of 6 of its members to form the Rights of Way Sub-Committee with the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson of the Development Control Committee fulfilling the same role for the Rights of Way Sub-Committee.
- 3.4 The recent Annual meeting of Council approved changes to the membership of the Development Control Committee and therefore the nomination and appointment to the Rights of Way Sub-Committee needs to be re-considered.
- 4. Current situation / proposal.
- 4.1 The Rights of Way Sub-Committee consists of and it is proposed shall continue to be six Members of the Development Control Committee.

4.2 The political balance of the Sub-Committee, was agreed by Council on 3 December 2008 and it is recommended remains as follows:-

Labour - 3 Members - (to include Chairperson and Liberal Democrats - 1 Member Vice-Chairperson of the Development Control

Conservative - 1 Member Committee)
