The application site was inspected by the Development Control Committee on 17th February 2016. The Ward Member, representatives of Ogmore Valley Community Council and one of the residents registered to speak and the applicant's agent were in attendance.

The committee report indicated that revised observations were expected from Natural Resources Wales (NRW) in response to the consultation undertaken in respect of the revised layout. Whilst NRW have noted that the revised housing layout fit's around the published Flood Map, the development fails to acknowledge that the Flood Map at this location may not show the true flood risk to this development proposal from the Ogwr Fach and the ordinary watercourse that runs through the site. No additional work on the Flood Consequence Assessment (FCA) and modelling has been undertaken and NRW request that the flood risk to the site from the Ogwr Fach and ordinary watercourse, and in particular overland flow and culvert blockage is assessed.

Natural Resources Wales have objected to the proposed development and requested that a revised FCA should be produced explaining how the flood risk will be managed.

RECOMMENDATION: That the application be DEFERRED to enable the developer to consider the observations from Natural Resources Wales and to submit a revised Flood Consequence Assessment detailing how the flood risk on the development site will be managed.
