- 2. Connection to Corporate Improvement Plan / Other Corporate Priority.
- 2.1 The establishment of Committees and other bodies will fulfil the requirements of the Constitution and enable the Council to work towards the successful achievement of its Corporate Priorities.

3. Background.

3.1 The Council is required by legislation and the provisions of Part 4 of the Rules of Procedure (Council Procedure Rules) of the Constitution, to undertake arrangements which will continue to facilitate and carry out the decision making processes of the Authority. The recommendations of this report, if adopted, will seek to ensure that this will be successfully achieved.

4. Current situation / proposal.

- 4.1 Part 3 of the Council's Constitution entitled Responsibility for Council Functions, sets out the Council's Committees, Sub-Committees, Panels and other bodies currently in place.
- 4.2 Overview and Scrutiny Committees Roles and Responsibilities.
- 4.2.1 At its meeting on 8 April 2015 Council approved changes to the titles, the membership, roles and responsibilities of the Scrutiny Committees.
- 4.3 The Audit Committee.
- 4.3.1 At its meeting on 16 April 2015, the Audit Committee considered a minor change (shown in bold) to its terms of reference as follows:

"To review **and approve** the Annual Statement of Accounts. Specifically, to consider whether appropriate accounting policies have been followed and whether there are concerns arising from the financial statements or from the audit that need to be brought to the attention of the Council".

- 4.3.2 The Audit Committee noted this change to its Terms of Reference and agreed that the change would be presented to Council for approval and inclusion in the constitution.
- 4.4 The updated functions of the Committees are shown at **Appendix 1** of the report. Following approval of this report, these committee functions will be incorporated into the Council's Constitution.
- 4.5 The revised committee structure is shown at **Appendix 2** to the report.
- 4.6 Political balance is essential to determine the allocation of seats on Committees. The Political balance requires updating to reflect changes to the political groups and the current vacancy in the Newcastle ward. The reduction in the membership of each of the Overview and Scrutiny Committees Scrutiny is also a significant factor in the allocation of committee seats.
- 4.7 The Local Government Act 1972 requires the publication of agenda and reports for formal meetings at least 3 working days before a meeting. Therefore the agenda and reports for this meeting must be published by 7 May 2015.
- 4.8 Without the result of the By-election for the Newcastle ward being known or the political allegiance of the successful candidate being identified at the time of publication of this report, an accurate political balance cannot be calculated. The result of the By-election will be known on 8th May 2015 and Members are therefore requested to note that the full detail of **Appendix 3** in respect of the political balance and the appointments to committees will be circulated to Members as soon as possible after the By-election and in advance of the Annual Meeting. Copies will also be available from the Democratic Services Section.
