M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

The council's cumulative impact/special saturation policy impacts upon this application in that the premises falls within the relevant areas defined in the Special Policy adopted on the 12th November 2014. The applicant understands that the effect of the Special Policy is that there is a presumption against granting any application for a premises licence that is likely to add to the cumulative impact. The operating schedule which forms part of this application describes the measures which the applicant will take to mitigate any such impact. The reasons why the applicant

contends that the application should be an exception to the policy are as follows:-

- 1. The applicant will surrender its existing premises licence under which the premises has been traded in the past.
- 2. The applicant reasonably expects that in the main its clientele will be patrons who already use the Bridgend town centre late night economy and its facilities and in consequence there will be no increased cumulative impact as such persons are already in the area using the facilities in Bridgend town centre independently of the applicant premises.
- 3. The location of the premises is very close to one of the main town centre taxi ranks serving the Bridgend town centre and is close to and on the route of recognised drop off points for persons and parties attending the Bridgend town centre.
- 4. The applicant therefore considers that it is unlikely that this licence will add to the cumulative impact on the licensing objectives.

The premises will remain open for 30 minutes beyond the terminal hour for the provision of licensable activities to enable clientele at the premises to continue to use the toilet facilities and to leave the premises and the area in an orderly manner.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1. CCTV will be provided in the form of a recordable system capable of providing pictures of evidential quality in particular facial recognition. Cameras will encompass all access to and exits from the premises including fire exits and all areas, with the exception of toilets, to which the public have access. The equipment will be maintained in good working order. The system will continuously record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain at the premises. Recordings will be timed and kept in date order for a period of 28 days and shall be handed to a police officer or local authority officer upon lawful demand. The designated premises supervisor will ensure that at all times a member of staff is on duty who is capable and competent to download CCTV recordings in a recordable format either to USB recorder or to disc, upon lawful demand by a police officer or local authority officer. The recording equipment will be kept in a secure environment under the control of the designated premises supervisor or another responsible named individual. An operational daily log will be maintained indicating that the system has been checked and is compliant. In the event of any failings of the system actions taken to rectify such failings will be recorded. If there is a technical failure of the CCTV equipment the designated premises supervisor will report such failure to the police.
- 2. Aside from off sales in sealed containers no glass wear or glass bottles will be taken outside the premises by patrons of the premises.
- 3. Door staff are to be employed at the premises. All such door staff will be SIA licensed door supervisors. Door staff will be employed at a ratio of one door supervisor per 100 premises customers who are on the premises.
- 4. A minimum of two SIA licensed door supervisors shall be on duty at all times when the premises is open for business.
- 5. A register of door supervisors will be maintained at all times at the premises. The register will include the name registration number contact details of the member of door staff along with a date time on duty and time off duty. Full details of any

agencies supplying door staff to the management of the premises will be endorsed on the register and the register will be available for inspection upon lawful request by a police officer or local authority officer.

- 6. Signs will be prominently displayed at the entrance to the premises and within the toilet facilities and at key strategic points within the premises to which the public have access, stating that drug use is unacceptable and that the venue operates a drug search policy as a condition of entry reserving the right to search customers under this provision.
- 7. The designated premises supervisor is to ensure that the premises actively participates in regular initiatives provided by South Wales Police to target drug misuse at the premises.
- 8. A drug safe will be present in the premises.
- 9. Either the designated premises supervisor or a manager appointed in his place will attend the Bridgend Pub and Club Watch Scheme meetings.
- 10. The premises is to participate in the night net radio communication scheme. Participation is to specifically include a member of staff responsible for signing on the system, monitoring responding to transmissions, making transmissions when incidents arise to alert other premises using the system and signing off. Such participation is to take place at all times when the premises is open to customers and trading.
- 11. The premises is to participate in all and any Bridgend town centre exclusion order schemes.
- 12. An incident book is to be maintained at all times to record any incidents of note at the premises and such incidents are to be recorded.

c) Public safety

- 1. The premises shall have an adequate system of counting persons in and out to ensure that customer levels in all areas of the premises do not exceed 400.
- 2. The number of customers permitted into the premises at any one time shall not exceed 400.
- 3. At least one suitably trained first aider shall be on duty when the premises is open to the public.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- 1. Loud speakers shall not be located in the entrance lobby or outside the building of the premises.
- 2. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exists requiring patrons to respect the needs of local people and to leave the area quietly.
- 3. Notices shall be prominently displayed at any area used for smoking requiring patrons to use the area quietly.
- 4. The designated premises supervisor shall ensure that any queue to enter the

premises which forms outside the premises is orderly and regularly supervised by	
door staff so as to ensure that the public highway is not obstructed and there is no	
public nuisance caused by such persons queuing to enter the premises.	

e) The protection of children from harm

- 1. A challenge 21 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable form of identification shall be identification which bears the photograph and date of birth of the holder together with an holographic mark of authenticity of such identification document.
- 2. A log shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The log shall include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log shall be made available for inspection at the premises upon lawful request by a police officer or an officer of the local authority at all times while the premises are open for business.
- 3. The designated premises supervisor shall keep up to date records of staff training in respect of age related products and sales.
- 4. Other than for a specific youth event which has been agreed in writing beforehand with the police licensing officer no person under the age of 18 is to be permitted entry to the premises.
- 5. Notices shall be clearly displayed in the premises to emphasise to customers the prohibition on providing sales of alcohol or the provision of alcohol to any person under the age of 18 years.

Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance
