

Phased Implementation

Phase 1

- Co-Located Multi-Agency Team including Children's Social Care who will:-
 - > Provide the Information, Assistance and Advice Service (IAA) screen referrals
 - Undertake Proportionate Assessment which could lead to :-
 - Strategy Discussion and Joint Section 47 enquiries where required.
 - Step down to Early Help.
 - Signpost to other agencies.

Phase 2

- Monitoring of potential CSE concerns and children who go missing to ensure compliance will All Wales Protocols.
- Adult Social Care Safeguarding.
- Monitoring and responses to missing children.

Phase 3

- Co-ordination and participation of MARAC and MAPPA arrangements
- Co-ordination and participation in Professional Strategy Meetings
