- 3.1 The Adjudication Panel for Wales (APW) is an independent tribunal that has been set up to determine alleged breaches against an authority's statutory Code of Conduct by elected and co-opted members of Welsh county, county borough and community councils, fire and national park authorities.
- 3.2 The APW has two statutory functions in relation to breaches of the Code of Conduct:
 - To form case or interim case tribunals to consider references from the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales, following the investigation of allegations that a member has failed to comply with their authority's Code of Conduct; and
 - To consider appeals from members against the decisions of local authority standards committees that they have breached the Code of Conduct.
