Constituency Activity

As your county councillor, my time is split between dealing with constituent queries & official duties in the council.

Constituent queries can range from very simple requests e.g. having the grass cut, to quite complex issues e.g. planning problems which can last up to a year.

In particular, this year I reported a number of issues in Coychurch village. Primarily issues to do with the new waste provision & lack of containers, fly tipping, pavement damage, fixing the ramp to the playground, potholes, grass cutting, blue badge appeals, weeds, access to properties on A473, drones, school parking problems, tree trimming, hedge trimming, noise disturbances, replacement of street lights, replacement footpath sign, & dog fouling issues. There are now “No HGV” signs at both ends of Tyn Y Caeau Lane and a litter bin opposite Brodingallt Farm.

In Waterton the new waste provision caused significant problems last year, which are now resolved and there was a specific planning issue involving an appeal.

In Brocastle there have been fewer issues, in particular, the new waste provision and how it would operate within the shared bin system.

I have provided constituents information on various topics e.g. privacy matters, sickness policies, library issues and allotments,

I have written a newsletter each month for the Coychurch Chronicle. This was also distributed through an email mailing list and my Facebook account. I have held monthly surgeries in the Williams Memorial Hall, Coychurch, both in the evenings and at lunchtimes. Any urgent information I have emailed to constituents and posted on both Twitter and Facebook. I have also posted a yearly newsletter of my annual report to every house in the constituency. By doing this I have contacted all constituents and ensured that they have access to the information that I disseminate.
