Role & Responsibilities

I was elected to Bridgend County Borough Council to represent Bryntirion, Laleston & Merthyr Mawr on 4th May 2012. I have undertaken a variety of roles within the council this year including being appointed to several committees.

I have supported the residents of my ward on a variety of issues and have formally raised 64 constituent queries with the council and other organisations. This is in addition to informally addressing a number of other issues which you have asked me to help you resolve.

To enable me to fulfil my role as your representative, I have attended a number of member development activities which have assisted me to ensure that my knowledge of national and local issues affecting the council and my ward is maintained.

Constituency Activity

I have supported the residents to address issues such as dog fouling, street lighting, parking issues and rubbish collections which have included complaints about non delivery of bags, boxes and collections. I have also been able support disabled constituents obtaining their blue badges and help them to address a number of social services enquiries.

Initiatives and Special Activities

It has been a very busy year for me as in addition to undertaking my responsibilities as a ward councillor, I was also elected to be the Mayor of Bridgend County Borough Council and the first citizen of the County Borough of Bridgend. I have sat on the Mayors Civic Charity Committee this year raising monies for my three charities including the Alzheimers Society, Breast Cancer Unit Princess of Wales Hospital and Bridgend Youth Theatre. My term of office ends on 23rd May 2018 when the new Mayor is elected.

Other Activities/Issues

I sit on Laleston Community Council and I am also a governor of Bryntirion Infants and Junior School. I also sit on the retired members forum for Unite the Union in Cardiff. I have attended meetings with the Labour Party and taken part in events. I took part in the "Stroke' Walk" on the 20/05/2017 in Newbridge Fields and raised monies for this much needed association.
