The email supports the Officer's recommendation.

Condition 3 currently reads:

The building shall be used for holiday accommodation and for no other purpose (including any other purpose in Class C3 of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 or in any provision equivalent to that Class in any Statutory Instrument revoking and re-enacting that Order with or without modification). The holiday let shall be occupied for holiday accommodation only and shall not be occupied as a person's or persons' sole or main place of residence and shall not be occupied by any person or persons for a period of more than 28 days in any 12 month period. An upto-date register shall be kept at the holiday accommodation hereby permitted and shall be made available for inspection by the Local Planning Authority upon request. The register shall contain details of the names of all of the occupiers of the accommodation, their main home addresses and their date of arrival and departure from the accommodation.

The applicant is concerned that the highlighted sentence implies that nobody can stay at the holiday accommodation and, for the avoidance of doubt and confusion, the relevant sentence can be changed to:

and shall not be occupied by the same person or persons for a period of more than 28 days in any 12 month period.

Condition 1 should be removed from the recommendation for the avoidance of doubt. The paragraph under "Impact on Residential Amenity" should refer to Pilkington level 5 obscurity and not Pilkington Level 3 obscurity.
