

M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

#### a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

The types of regulated entertainments proposed enhance and augment the normal food catering facility. Staff will be trained on the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 when they are recruited. No new steps have been identified by risk assessment in relation to the four licensing objectives except as below. We have considered the terms of your local Licensing Policy in preparing this application.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Insofar as may be relevant, given that the provision of alcohol is secondary to the provision of food, to provide a 30 minute extension to opening hours after the end of alcohol sales with access to the Premises toilet facilities and the provision of non-alcoholic refreshment during such period..

It is intended that the Personal Licence holder will be present on the Premises whenever trading and if for any reason the Personal Licence holder herself cannot be present then written authority will be given by the DPS to another appropriate person trained in the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 or a personal Licence Holder in their own right. No less than five working days written notice will be given to the polce if required when "Events Days" are planned.

The DPS is prepared o be a member of the local Pubwatch scheme.

#### c) Public safety

Normal catering numbers will not be exceeded and for functions the numbers will be limited to 75 persons or such other number as the consultative authorities shall determine. No specific risks regarding public safety have been identified. In the very unlikely event that a risk of overcrowding is identified (i.e on Event Days) the DPS will liaise with both the police and the fire authority to discuss how best to deal with any issue.

The Applicant and her staff will continue to assess all aspects of the Health & Safety at Work etc Act 1974 and prominent signs relating to nearest fire exits will be displayed together with a notice of the fire policy to be adopted in the event of an emergency.

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

All windows will be kept closed after 23.00.

All amplified music shall be inaudible at the façade of the nearest residential premises after 23.00

There shall be no removal of waste bottles after 23.00

Any live music will end at 02.00 except on Ban Holidays, New Years Eve and New Years Day
