Decision Made	<p>The Regional Armed Forces Covenant Liaison Officer delivered this report outlining the details and importance of the Armed Forces Covenant, which is a scheme designed to highlight struggles veterans face in transitioning away from Forces work, and to enable organisations to meet their unique requirements. This report was delayed briefly due to IT difficulties.</p> <p>Members posed questions about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sharing the presentation for easy distribution• Focusing on allotment allocation for ex-service personnel use <p>These questions were addressed by the Chairperson and the Regional Armed Forces Covenant Liaison Officer, with the Chairperson looking forward to potential utilization of the Covenant by local Councils.</p> <p>RESOLVED: The Forum noted the report, acknowledging that BCBC has an excellent record of assisting former Armed Forces personnel and that there is lots to do for further accommodating ex-Forces people's transition into civilian life.</p>

Decision Made	<p>The Climate Change Response Officer presented a report on the INNS (invasive non-native species) to the UK such as Japanese knotweed and Himalayan Balsam, ways of identifying and managing their spread alongside recording the effects of their presence.</p> <p>Questions were posed on the subjects of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• How to raise invasive species reports for members inside and outside BCBC• Options for offline methods of communication for residents and members• BCBC’s record of INNS control on their own premises• BCBC Contractors’ understanding of Invasive Species prevention methods <p>These questions were addressed by the Climate Change Response Officer and the Corporate Director for Communities, with the Corporate Director for Communities asking for records of incidents of incorrect INNS removal.</p> <p><u>RESOLVED:</u> The Forum noted the report.</p>
