6	Members discussed the implications of Legal Services for schools expressing their concerns with more complex casework involving behaviour, attendance, health, and safety legislation.  Headteachers advised they have external arrangements with legal services who are knowledgeable and are able to turn things around in a timely manner to support schools. Headteachers stated that the conflict came where the Local Authorities' legal team may not agree with the external legal advice which could be a challenge for the schools. The Committee requested that this is investigated further as to whether the external legal support was sustainable, manageable, affordable and whether the support was sufficient for today's demands on schools.	The Legal Services for Schools Service Level Agreement (SLA) has been in place for several years. Feedback from headteachers has generally been positive in respect of the current arrangements. The local authority has explored whether this function could be brought 'in-house' and, despite some effort to do so, we received limited interest from the market. In addition, the current arrangements offer an effective service which is provided on a cost-effective basis. The local authority would be happy to liaise with headteachers to explore alternative options following the expiration of the current contract with the Legal Services for Schools SLA.	Accepted
