
South Wales Police object to the attached application under the licensing objective of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

South Wales Police are of the opinion the applicant is not a fit and proper person to hold a Temporary Event Notice.

The applicant states within her application that 'Talks have been made with the local policing licencing team regarding this and they have said they are in support/ can not see any reasons why this can not be managed safely. They sent out the appropriate forms to aid in my application'. At no time has South Wales Police Licensing Officers had any contact with the applicant, sent out appropriate forms, or stated we are in support of the event.

Within the application the applicant has applied for the sale of alcohol, regulated entertainment, and late-night refreshment from 18:00 to 05:00 hours on Saturday 14th February 2026 at Newbridge Fields. Newbridge Fields is an open recreation area within Bridgend Town Centre which is utilised for numerous sporting events and activities.

The applicant has not provided any risk assessment with the TEN, nor have they indicated how they will ensure the safety of 499 persons as indicated on the application, who will be able to consume alcohol until the early hours of the morning, there is also no indication of how the applicant intends to monitor the dispersal of those attending.




