## LICENSING ACT 2003

### APPLICATION UNDER SCHEDULE 8 FOR OF A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

BRIDGEND ROAD, ABERKENFIG, CF32 9AP

The above application has been examined by this Department in its role as a Responsible Authority. Consideration has been given to issues in connection with the Health & Safety at Work Etc Act 1974, pollution of the environment harm to human health and protection of children. I can advise you that the Department has the following relevant representations to make from Trading Standards :-

Following review of the details, I fully support the review presented in light of the breaches highlighted. Although TS have no relevant further input, we are concerned as to the mention of underage persons being present when occurrences have been dealt with.

It would appear that based on the many licensing breaches, along with evidence surrounding the use of illegal workers, then these authorities may then wish to present representations surrounding these relevant factors.

Analysis of the TS database reveals no record of the exercise concerning the mention of an operation in March 2011. This conveys that TS and South Wales police worked together on such an exercise, but no evidence can be located on this point about our involvement.
