OMBUDSMAN ANNUAL LETTER

1. Purpose of Report

1.1 To provide Members with a copy of the Ombudsman's Annual Letter.

3. Background

3.1 The Ombudsman's Office publishes an Annual Letter detailing the performance of the Authority against an average for Local Authorities in Wales and the wider public sector report which contains statistical information about complaints considered in the year.

4. Current situation / proposal

- 4.1 The Ombudsman's Annual Letter shows a large increase in the number of complaints relating to children's social services and planning. It is the case however that no complaints have been upheld and timely responses have been provided. Informal resolution continues to be successful although again, fewer cases required this than in the previous year.
- 4.2 In respect of Model Code of Conduct cases there has been a significant increase in complaints although these have ultimately not been formally investigated.
