CODE OF CONDUCT – Declaration of personal interests for inclusion in the public register of members' interests

COUNCILLOR'S NAME: ...Cllr. B. Jones...

ADVICE TO COUNCILLORS:

The law, and the Council's Code of Conduct, require you to declare personal interests. Some personal interests have to be recorded by you in the statutory public register, **within 28 days** of your election or appointment to office, and have to be updated by you **within 28 days** of any change.

(There is an exemption from having to declare "sensitive information"; the Monitoring Officer can advise you about this).

This form enables you to record those interests, or to show that you have no such interests to declare.

Please remember that you still have to declare any relevant interests (including those in this Register) where they relate to matters under consideration at a meeting – please look at the Council's Code of Conduct for the rules on this.

Please complete, sign and date either Box A or Box B below, and return the form to the Monitoring Officer.

Box C can be used to update the information previously supplied by you.
